Site Coordinator for Teen Trendsetter After-School Program: One (1) teacher/administrator at ZHS to coordinate dates and times for high school mentors to work with elementary after-school students utilizing The Barbara Bush Teen Trendsetter model. The Site Coordinator will involve staff, parents, mentors, and students in understanding the program and coordinate training opportunities for student mentors, who will be receiving flex credit for their participation. The Site Coordinator will also institute a train-the-trainer model for mentors to use Study Island, Reading Eggs, and Education City with elementary students.
