## New building will bring vocational options

Construction is under way at the Administration Center and Zanesville Community High School property on Moxahala Avenue for a building that will eventually house yet-to-be determined



vocational programs for both ZCHS and ZCS students. The District is working with Mid-East Career & Technical Centers to determine programming, which could easily change based on regional needs due to the “plug and play” design. The building is funded with a 50/50 Ohio Facilities Construction Commission grant. ZCS and ZCHS qualified for the grant due to the “Exemplary” rating on the ZCS sponsor report card and the “Excellent” rating on the ZCHS report card last school year.
