Youth suicide workshop set for Thursday, Nov. 8th



Our District and Allwell Behavioral Health Services (formerly Six-County Inc.) are collaborating on a one-night workshop entitled “DANGER ZONE: Understanding Youth Suicide.”

This workshop begins at 6 p.m. Thursday, November 8th, in the ZHS Cafetorium. Free childcare and refreshments will be provided.

The program will be led by Jim Still-Pepper, LSW, of Allwell. This is an opportunity to “learn how to work together to prevent suicide, understand warning signs, and learn strategies for how to intervene.”

Suicide is the second-leading cause of death in the United States among 15 to 24-year-olds, behind only unintentional injuries.

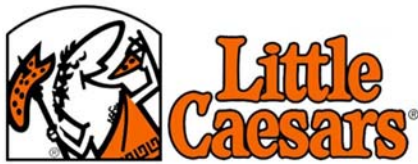
