The Arrangements & Hospitality Team serves as regional liaisons at OSBA's Capital Conference Region Resource Center. Her appointment is effective January 1, 2019.

The Southeast Region membership is comprised of 16 districts, five exempted village districts, 48 local districts, nine vocational school districts, and six educational service centers, for a total of 84 member boards of education across 18 counties. The region has nearly 400 board members and more than 119,000 students.
