Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Education of the Zanesville City School District, Muskingum County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Board of Education hereby authorizes the Superintendent to act on behalf of the Board with respect to resolution of Contractor claims and to consider and approve contractor bulletins, field work orders and Change Orders which modify the Contract Documents, including minor substitutions of materials and equipment, and increases in any Contract amount up to \$25,000 provided that the Superintendent shall not approve, sign or deliver any such change order that would require the District to spend an additional amount for costs of the School Facilities Improvement Project unless the Treasurer of this Board shall certify that there is available, or in the process of collection, to the credit of an appropriate fund and not encumbered for any other purpose the amount needed to meet the School District's additional obligations incurred by virtue of the Change Order. The Board further authorizes the Superintendent to act on behalf of the Board with respect to decisions required by the Board for the Project, which includes the authority to approve the project schedule and amendments to the project schedule.

- **Section 2.** The authorized representative's authority shall, where applicable, be subject to the following limitations:
- a. The Board shall approve any Contractor bulletins, field work orders or Change Orders which substantially modify the Contract Documents and involve increases in any Contract amount over \$25,000.
- b. The authorized representative shall not undertake any of the responsibilities of the Architect, Construction Manager or Contractors.

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- c. The authorized representative shall communicate with the Construction Manager regarding safety concerns, precautions and programs in connection with the Work.
- d. The authorized representative shall confer with the Construction Manager and, whenever practicable, the Board, on expediting the Work for a Contractor or their subcontractors and material suppliers.
