#10-108 AGREEMENT BETWEEN ZANESVILLE CITY SCHOOLS AND OHIO UNIVERSITY ZANESVILLE

Mrs. Stewart moved and Mr. Eppley seconded to enter into an Agreement between Zanesville City Schools and Ohio University Zanesville Campus for the propose to offer Math 113, Algebra, a 5-credit Ohio University math course that is equivalent to one of Zanesville High School's math courses. The class will be taught by one of Zanesville City High School faculty with at least a Master's degree in Mathematics. The qualifications of the instructor must be approved by the Chair of the Mathematics Department at Ohio University in Athens. Supervision of the Ohio University equivalency of the course will be undertaken by Dr. Pramod Kanwar, Associate Professor of Mathematics at Ohio University - Zanesville.

Dr. Kanwar will assure O.U. equivalency by supervising selection of the textbook, the class syllabus, breadth of course content, and equivalency of examinations. The students will enroll in one advanced class. Ohio University credit will be issued only for those students who achieve a grade of "C" or better by O.U. standards. There will be no penalty for those students who attempt the O.U. credit but fail to achieve it. (They will still receive the same grade they would have earned in the regular Zanesville High School math class.)

Propose the following criteria for student eligibility in the program:

- The student is eligible to take the math course by standard existing criteria at Zanesville High School.
- The students will take all parts of the COMPASS Placement Exam and place at Placement Level One (PL1) or higher in the math component of the exam. OUZ will arrange for the COMPASS test to be administered at OUZ campus or Zanesville High School on our (OUZ) laptop computers or via a distance hook-up over the Internet.
- The student has a minimum GPA of 2.5 at Zanesville High School.

Propose the following in regard to financial matters:

- Zanesville High School/Zanesville School Board will remit to Ohio University Zanesville \$100 per student credit hour issued. (\$500 per student if it is a 5-credit course.) This is an amount that has been standardized among the five Ohio University regional campuses. This fee will apply to a maximum of twenty students. There will be no charge for more than twenty students in one class achieving credit for this course.
- There will be no charge for students enrolled in the class who do not achieve Ohio University credit.
- Ohio University- Zanesville will share the cost of the textbooks (50% OUZ; 50% Zanesville High School). Zanesville High School/Zanesville School Board will retain ownership of the textbooks for use in subsequent years.
