WHEREAS, on June 17, 2014, this Board adopted a resolution declaring it necessary to submit to the electors of the District the question of the renewal of an existing tax levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation, as described below, a copy of which resolution was certified to the Muskingum County Auditor; and WHEREAS, that County Auditor subsequently certified to this Board that the total tax (assessed) valuation of the District is \$369,223,950 and that the estimated annual tax levy required throughout the life of the proposed levy to produce the annual amount of \$1,438,952, as set forth in that resolution, calculated in the manner provided by Section 5705.195 of the Revised Code, is 3.9 mills for each one

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Zanesville City School District, County of Muskingum, State of Ohio, that:

Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 4. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.

K. EXECUTIVE SESSION

WHEREAS board of education and other governmental bodies are required by statue "to take official action and to conduct all deliberations upon official business only in open meetings, unless the subject matter is specifically exempted by law";

WHEREAS "the minutes need only reflect the general subject matter of discussions in executive session", and

WHEREAS the members of a public body may hold an executive session only at a regular or special meeting for the sole purpose of consideration of any of the matters set forth below.
