DLT meetings this year will be conducted on Zoom, and will begin at 3:30 p.m. on the second Thursday of each month during the school year.

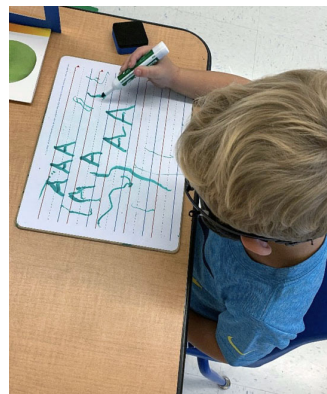
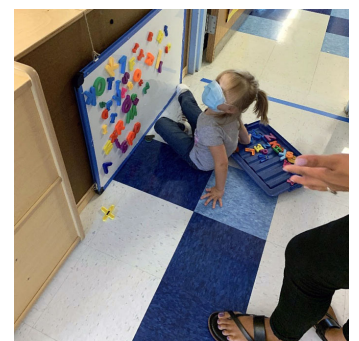
