6. Eureka Math/Engage NY for 3-6

Adopt Eureka Math/ Engage NY for grades 3-6 mathematics beginning the 2018-19 academic year. Seven teachers received PD in June of 2016 on this research-based program. The results of students in classrooms who implemented this widely were impressive. All resources are available online, so the only cost is printing. It aligns well with Ohio's learning standards, our pacing guides, and assessment expectations. Professional development will be provided on district PD days and in PLC throughout this academic year to provide for a smooth transition. MyMath and Glencoe will no longer be used after this academic year.
